

OUR CONFERENCE

For the past 15 years, Invest For Kids has been Chicago's flagship investment conference.

- Our Audience: The conference typically attracts over 1,000 guests and includes portfolio managers, investment advisors, analysts, family offices, and private investors.
- Our Speakers: The most well-known and successful investors in the world take our stage to share their best investment ideas with our audience, as well as their perspectives on macroeconomic, political, and investment themes.
- Our Impact: IFK's co-founders underwrite all conference expenses so that 100% of the funds raised go directly to support children from under-resourced communities in the Chicago area. In the past 15 years, we have raised and donated over \$22 million to over 90 organizations.

Our 16th annual conference will be held on Tuesday, October 22nd and will include a networking luncheon at 11:30 a.m. The conference will begin at 1:00 p.m. and conclude at 4:00 p.m.

BECOME A SPONSOR

The best way to support Invest For Kids is to become an annual sponsor. Sponsors receive many benefits, including brand recognition at the conference and throughout the year. Most importantly, your support allows high performing nonprofit organizations to receive the critical funding they need to provide programs and services to Chicago-area youth, their families, and their communities. We offer three types of sponsorships:

- **General Sponsorship:** This sponsorship includes branding opportunities based on level at both the conference and year-round through e-blast and website acknowledgment. Each sponsorship comes with a specific allotment of conference tickets that can be utilized for employees, clients or other professional contacts.
- Student Sponsorship: In addition to branding opportunities, this \$25,000 sponsorship allows students from local universities to attend the conference free of charge. Sponsors direct their sponsorship toward a local university of choice or IFK can select. Each sponsorship allows 25 students to attend the event.
- Women's Sponsorship: As a part of IFK's long term commitment to supporting women in the finance industry, the
 women's sponsorship allows female professionals or students to attend the conference and a special networking
 event immediately after the event. Each \$15,000 sponsorship includes tickets for 20 women, either from the
 sponsors' network or from the IFK community.
